WTPA Disclosure Statement updated 10-13-23

Representatives of the proposed West Tennessee Pickleball Association (WTPA) have had numerous meetings with Mayor Conger and employees of the Jackson Recreation and Parks Department (JRPD) to request improvements to and expansion of Conger Park as well as to discuss options to meet the increased demands for pickleball courts across the city. We have been encouraged by his commitment:

- 1. Six additional courts at Conger Park (\$200,000, which will be presented to the City Council on 7/1/23)
- 2. Conversion of the North Park tennis courts to sixteen pickleball courts in 2024. (\$500,000)
- 3. Six courts at the South Jackson Community Center in 2025.
 - a. Repairs at Conger Park:
 - b. Sidewalks
 - c. Grading of the hill between the two courts for a viewing area
 - d. Restroom renovations (in progress)

Mayor Conger recognizes the popularity of pickleball and the importance of a long-range plan to meet these demands. In return, he has asked to work with representatives, rather than the community at large. At a minimum, a pickleball association will serve as that voice and advocate for the players.
